KS2 SATS

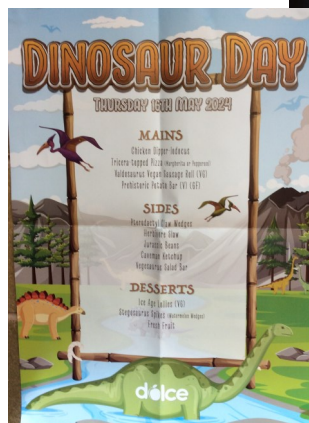
We would like to say a huge well done to all of Year 6, who have worked incredibly hard this week on their KS2 SATs.
