Independence

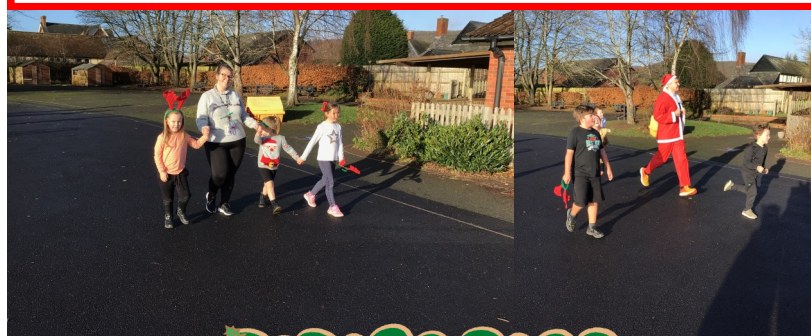
