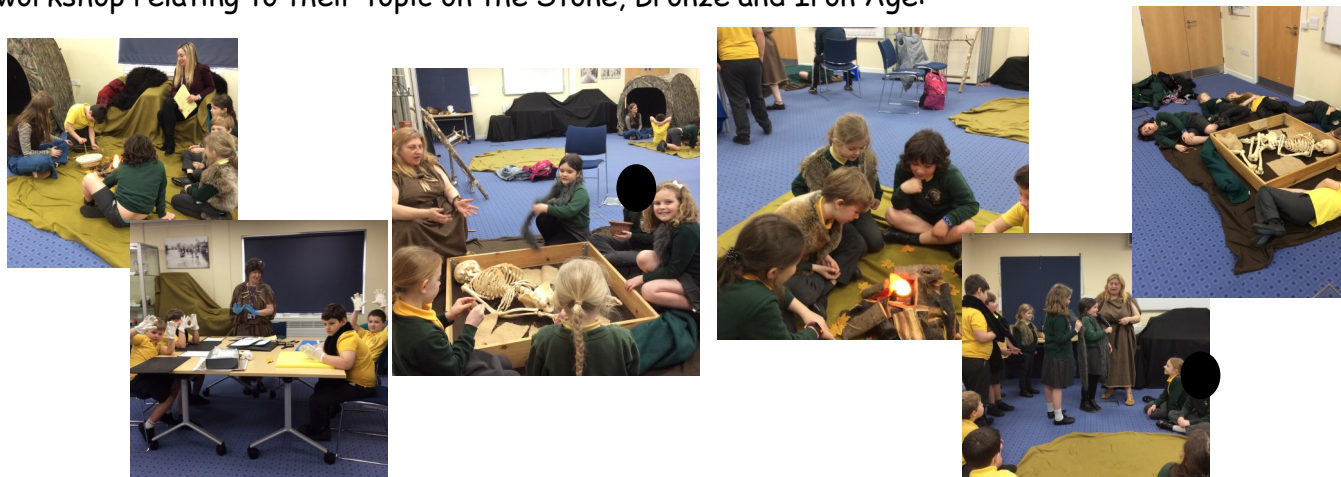
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Zog and The Flying Doctors

Internet Safety Tip

This week we look at YouTube - currently the most used app by children for viewing content. It's always good to be reminded that YouTube is a 13+ app so our children should not be using it. As an alternative, there is always YouTube kids which filters out a lot of the harmful content that can be seen on the full version.

Please see the guide (to the right) on to how to turn on 'restricted mode' on the full version of YouTube. This may prove useful for some.



Restricted Mode

Turn on restricted mode filtering with these simple instructions:

- On your home screen tap on your profile picture in the top right corner.
- Scroll down and tap on 
- Swipe the tab to the right to activate **Restricted Mode**
