The whole team played amazingly well - a real team performance. We are all so proud of them!





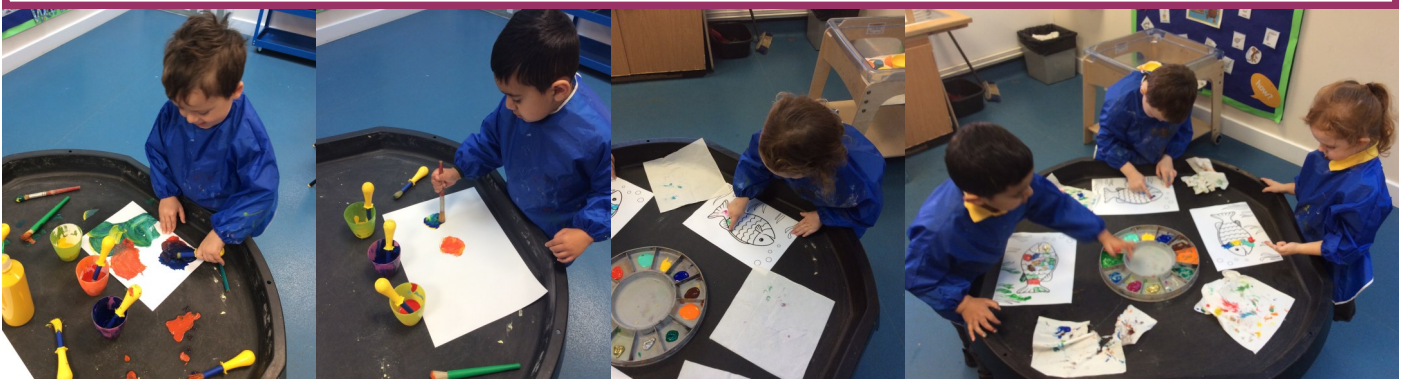
Red Squirrels had a lovely Forest School session on Friday, embracing the crisp, sunny, autumnal weather.
