We have experienced a wide range of weather in Wellington over the past few weeks; from flooding to snow!

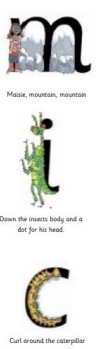
The children have fully embraced all weathers, and absolutely loved the snowy weather. They enjoyed working together to build a snowman and a snow dog.
