The work is set to commence on 21st July at the start of school holidays.

Fundraising has been very successful and there is already enough money for:

- Play equipment (as voted for by Wellington children)
- Ground works and play surfaces
- Fencing
- Signs and security

Student voice recently met to discuss the results of our school charity vote. The result were as follows:

- Little Princess Trust - 10 votes
- **St. Michael's hospice - 12 votes**
- Guide Dog's Association - 10 votes
- **Cancer Research - 12 votes**
- Alzheimer's society- 9 votes



Following the vote, a very long discussion was held about both winning charities. Student Voice discussed why the students felt these charities were important and they then took a second anonymous vote (within school council):

- St. Michael's Hospice - 3 votes (including Miss Evans)
- Cancer Research - 5 votes

Cancer Research has been chosen as our school charity for 2025.
