We won 1-0 in our league game and then the girls won their semi-final match 4-1.

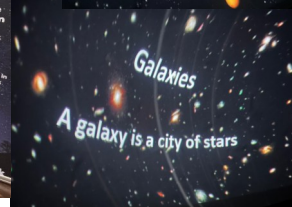
The girls will play in the cup final after the May half term.
