As it is the start of a new academic year, we wanted to remind all children and their families of our fantastic reward systems in school.

Star of the week certificates (and badge)

Each week a child from each class is celebrated as our 'star of the week.' This is awarded to a child who consistently demonstrates fantastic behaviour and follows our golden rules.



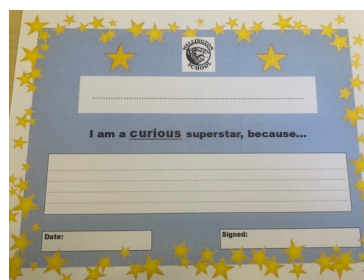
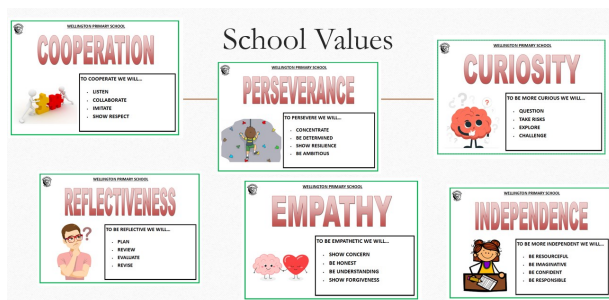
Well done certificates

A well done certificate is awarded to one child from each class for particularly impressing with one piece of outstanding work or fantastic effort in a particular lesson.



Values certificate

We have six school values, one per half-term. These are curiosity, independence, empathy, reflectiveness, perseverance and cooperation. One child from each class will receive a certificate each week for demonstrating that value.



Rainbow reading

We encourage all children to read as much as possible at home and we reward all children who have read five times with a rainbow reading certificate. Once a child has earned five certificates they are able to select a book as a prize.



Attendance reward

Weekly attendance figures are read out in assembly each week. The winning class gets extra time in our outside play area on a Friday.

The class which then has the best attendance across a whole term is rewarded with a pizza party.



Dojos

Dojo points are rewarded throughout each and every day at school. These are earned for working hard, demonstrating good behaviour, showing excellent manners, completing homework and for all manner of situations where a member of staff feels a child deserves a reward.

Once a child receives 100 dojos, they will be able to select a small prize in the weekly celebration assembly.
